Quick-start Guide to Streaming Your Neighborhood Project Episodes:

COMPUTER to TV via a CABLE

1 Make sure the computer you're using can reach your TV with a cable.

They make some pretty long cables, but if you're using a desktop on the second floor and your TV is on the first floor, this option probably won't work. But fear not, there's another option. You can stream wirelessly. Check that out in our online host toolkit (you'll have to login here).

2 Get your episode cued up on your computer.

Not sure how to do that? Go to member content and click "watch episodes" (again, you'll have to login here to do this).

3 Figure out which cable works for you.

If you don't have the appropriate HDMI cable for your computer, check for an input that looks like one of the cables below. Click the cable below to purchase a recommended 10' cable from Amazon.com.

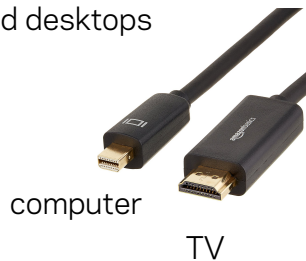
1. HDMI to HDMI

Works with some earlier MacBook Pros, most PC laptops and desktops



2. Mini Displayport to HDMI

Works with most Mac laptops and desktops



3. USB C to HDMI

Works with most-recent MacBook Pro and PC laptops



Still not sure? You can ask your local computer store or a local Staples or Best Buy. They'll guide you to the correct cable.

4 Connect your Computer to your TV using the HDMI adapter.

5 Test your episode before your guests arrive.
