Quick-start Guide to Streaming Your Neighborhood Project Episodes:

MOBILE DEVICE to TV via WiFi

1 Get your episode cued up on your Mobile Device.

Login at theneighborhoodproject.com, go to member content and click "watch episodes" to play this month's episode.

2 Identify your receiving device.

To connect your mobile device via wifi usually requires a receiving device such as a Smart TV, Apple TV, Google Chromecast, Roku, or Amazon FireTV. In general, the mobile device you use will determine which receiving device you can use:



From iOS devices such as iPhone & iPad to Apple TV



From Android devices such as Google, HTC, LG, Moto & Samsung to Google Chromecast, Roku or Amazon Fire TV receivers

3 Connect your Mobile Device to your TV via Wifi.

To mirror your mobile device's screen to your TV screen, be sure you are on the same Wifi network as your receiving device, then select the icon like one of the above in the video player control area. Click that icon and select your receiving device by name to mirror your mobile device's screen to your TV.

If you are having trouble connecting, consult your receiving device's instruction manual to learn how to mirror your mobile device's screen to your TV screen.

4 Test your episode before your guests arrive.

This is really important to do when streaming via wifi. Play the episode through to make sure it's streaming properly. Trouble shooting suggestion: keep other folks off the network when streaming (don't want anyone else eating up that bandwidth).
